Drug testing Program

NBCC and BCC, both our locations, offer a drug-testing program is designed to detect the presence of alcohol, illicit drugs, or certain prescription drugs.

We use a certified lab, Atlantic Diagnostic Laboratories, and follow appropriate guidelines for drug testing.

Types of Drug tests

Drug tests can vary depending on the types of drugs being tested and the specimens used, such as urine or oral fluid (saliva).

Tests are commonly used for the following categories of drugs:

ETG, Alcohol, Amphetamine/
Methamphetamine, Barbiturates,
Benzodiazepines, Buprenorphine, Cocaine,
Fentanyl, Marijuana, Methadone/EDDP,
Opiates, Oxycodone, PCP, Kratom, K2,
Tramadol, Creatinine, Oxidants, and pH
